## **Reyat's Guilty Plea**

Last week, we mailed you packages to inform you of the National Parole Board and Correctional Services of Canada process. Correctional Services of Canada is responsible for managing penitentiaries that house offenders serving sentences of two years and more. The National Parole Board is an administrative tribunal that has exclusive authority to grant, deny or revoke parole or, under certain circumstances, to order the detention of offenders subject to statutory release.

In this package you will find two registration forms. If you wish to be informed of any applications Mr. Reyat brings forward to the National Parole Board and or if you would like to be informed of his whereabouts and when he should be able to apply for early parole, please complete the forms and forward them to the National Parole Board, Pacific Regional Office, 32315 South Fraser Way, Suite 305, Abbotsford, BC.
